

FONT SOFTWARE END USER LICENSE AGREEMENT ☺

Please take your time to read this,
we made it very simple!

This End User License Agreement ("EULA") explains how you are allowed to use the Font Software created by **Anna Zimmermann, Liza Borovskaya-Brodskaya** and **Stefanie Wurnitsch** ("Licensors"). By downloading, installing, or using the fonts, you accept these terms. This EULA applies to the following Typeface(s): **AZ Welding Mono Regular**, **AZ Welding Mono Medium**, and **AZ Welding Mono Bold**.

1. What This EULA Covers

1.1 What "Typeface" Means

The Typeface is the visual design of the letters and symbols.

1.2 What "Font Software" Means

The Font Software is the digital file that produces the Typeface on your screen or in print, including any styles, formats, updates, or documentation provided.

1.3 What "Project" Means

A Project is the specific job or assignment for which you purchased the license.

1.4 What "Licensors" Means

The designers of the Font Software: Liza Borovskaya-Brodskaya, Stefanie Wurnitsch and Anna Zimmermann.

1.5 What "Users" Means

"User" means the individual or legal entity who has purchased or otherwise acquired the license to use the Font Software under this EULA.

2. Your License to Use the Font

2.1 Who May Use the Font

You receive a non-exclusive, non-transferable license to use the Font Software for one (1) project.

- If you're an individual buyer: the license applies only to you.
- If you're a designer working for a client: the client must buy their own license (If the client is a company see next point).
- If you're and company or other for-profit organization: The number of licenses required corresponds to the total number of employees, regardless of the actual number of users of the Typeface. You may contact the Licensors (Liza Borovskaya-Brodskaya, Stefanie Wurnitsch and Anna Zimmermann) to discuss a custom licensing agreement if needed.

2.2 Where You May Use the Font

You may use the Font Software in:

- printed materials
- digital documents
- social media
- websites
- film, video, and cinema

2.3 Logo Use Needs a Separate License

Using the Font Software for a logo, wordmark, or trademark requires a separate license.

Please contact the Licensors if you want to do this.

3. What You May Not Do

You may not:

- Modify, edit, reverse engineer, decompile, or access the source code of the Font Software.
- Remove or change any embedded copyright notices or credits.
- Share, lend, or give the Font Software to anyone else.
- Allow others to install or use the Font Software

- without their own license.
- Embed the Font Software in apps, software, products, or templates if this would allow end users to create new content with the font or extract the font.
- Use the Typeface in racist, anti-LGBTQ+, nationalist, pornographic, or otherwise harmful or malicious contexts.

4. Copyright and Ownership

The Font Software is protected by copyright and remains the intellectual property of the Licensors.

You are buying a license to use the fonts, not ownership of the fonts themselves.

5. Warranty and Liability

5.1 Warranty

The Font Software is provided "as is", as far as the law allows.

This means the Licensors do not promise that the fonts will work in every situation, on every device, or without errors. You are responsible for how the Font Software performs on your system.

5.2 Limitation of Liability (International Version)

To the maximum extent allowed by law, the Licensors are not responsible for indirect or unexpected damages such as data loss, lost profits, or business interruption.

This clause does not limit liability in situations where the law does not allow limitations (for example, intentional wrongdoing or gross negligence). This is required under EU and many international laws.

6. Consumer Rights (EU Only)

If you are an EU consumer purchasing the Font Software online, local consumer rights may apply.

You may be asked to confirm that you want the download to start immediately and understand that this may waive your 14-day withdrawal right, as required by EU law.

7. Governing Law

This EULA is governed by Austrian law, unless the mandatory consumer laws of your country require otherwise. For business users outside the EU, Austrian law applies exclusively.

8. Term and Termination

8.1 How Long the License Lasts

Your license lasts for the duration of the project for which it was purchased.

8.2 When the License Ends Automatically

The license will end automatically if you break the terms of this EULA.

8.3 What Happens When It Ends

When your project ends – or the license ends due to a breach – you must delete all copies of the Font Software and its accompanying materials.

9. Final Terms

If any part of this EULA is found invalid, the rest remains in effect. Not enforcing a right immediately does not waive that right. This EULA is the entire agreement between you and the Licensors regarding the Font Software.
